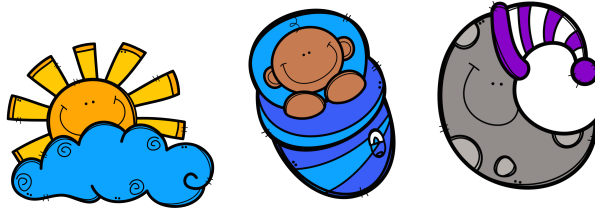

Literacy Tips for Caregivers of Babies

LITERACY TIP: Talking

When we talk about the sequence of our days with our children, they have a chance to hear vocabulary words in context and begin to learn how to put events in order...both skills that help with comprehension when they are readers.

LITERACY MESSAGE: Reading

The next time you go into a bakery with your baby, spend a little time pointing to and reading the labels for all the different kinds of treats. You will be helping your child start to make the connection between the words we say and the words on signs and labels. As they get older, they'll start to understand that reading is something we do all the time, not just when we read books!

Nicole's Early Literacy Tips:

- **READING:** *Plastic bath books are great to read during baths!*
- **WRITING:** *Foam letters and bath crayons can be used to write your little one's name (alphabet)*
- **TALKING:** *You can work on your child's vocabulary by pointing out body parts as you wash them*
